Key elements of the Networks

- ✓ Patient centered and clinically lead
- ✓ 10 Members in at least 8 Countries
- ✓ Strong independent (3rd party) assessment
- ✓ Fulfillment of Network and Members criteria
- ✓ Endorsement and approval by National Authorities (grouping and strategic value)





Networks criteria and capacities



- knowledge and expertise to diagnose, follow up and manage patients
- ✓ Evidence of good outcomes
- ✓ multi-disciplinary approach
- ✓ capacity to produce good practice guidelines and to implement outcome measures and quality control
- ✓ Research, teaching and training
- ✓ collaborate with other centers of expertise and networks





Member's general criteria



1. Set of horizontal criteria and conditions to be fulfilled by all healthcare providers regardless of the field of expertise

5 groups 22 criteria

- a) patients empowerment and centred care
- b) organisational, management and business continuity
- c) research and training capacity
- d) exchange of expertise, information systems and e-health tools
- e) expertise, good practice, quality, patients safety and evaluation





Member's specific criteria

Set of specific criteria and conditions may vary depending on the scope of the concrete area of expertise

- ✓ documented competence, experience and activity
- ✓ provide evidence of good clinical care and outcomes
- characteristics of human resources
- ✓ organisation and functioning: multidisciplinary healthcare team
- ✓ specific equipment within the centre or easily accessible
- ✓ communication / interaction at a distance capacity

Based on the evidence and consensus of the scientific, technical and professional community

Bottom up proposals









How to assess and approve the Networks?







Key role of Member States

- ✓ Recognition of centers at national level. (important differences) MS with systems in place (minority)
- ✓ Endorsement of applications
- ✓ Board of Member States
- ✓ Approval of Networks (once positively assessed)

 - ✓ Approval of Networks and Membership
 - ✓ Termination of Networks
 - ✓ Loss of Membership



- Minutes and rules approved and made public (DG SANTE website)
- ✓ Voting rules
- ✓ Co-Chair Member States elected: Till Voigtländer (Austria)
- □ 3 meetings in 2015 (June, October, December)

Network proposals: Preparatory and strategic activities

- ✓ Strengthening the network value and capacities:
 - Multidisciplinarity
 - Avoid fragmentation: Grouping of diseases
 - ☐ Identify mature and clear EU added value type of diseases
 - □ Discuss and *Identify other players, partners and members*
- ✓ **Liaison with MS authorities** (contact with ERN board representative at national level and discuss !!)
- **✓** Define the services of the Nework







Network proposals: Preparatory and strategic activities (2)

- ✓ Agree on the specific criteria for each area of expertise
- ✓ Self-assessment exercise (Network and members)
- ✓ Define **Pathways** models, referral criteria, clinical decision tools
- ✓ **Information** system/indicators







Challenges



- Engagement of providers and national authorities
- Attract and approve the right Networks and Centers
- Being able to produce evidence of its value:
 - Clinical outcomes,
 - Better access to care
 - efficiency
- Sustainability
